Produce an information page about your favourite Star Wars character.	If two 3-D shapes have the same number of edges, then they also have the same number of vertices. Do you agree? Explain why.	Astronauts need to be healthy. Create a workout and upload to Seesaw.
Write a review about your favourite book about space. Can you write another chapter or section to your book?	Use facts to help you calculate: How many seconds in an hour? How many minutes in a day? How many minutes in a week? How many hours in a year? Can you make any more calculations of your own?	Design your own planet. It's your world... be creative! What rules/laws would you have? Where would houses be built? How would people travel around? What would schools/jobs be like? How many countries would there be? Who would be in charge?
On your own or with a friend(s), recreate a TV style news bulletin about the first moon landing. Perhaps you could include an interview with Neil Armstrong? Film and upload to Seesaw so we can watch in class.	Create a space-themed board game which challenges your number skills. You could base it on a familiar game you already play. Play the game with your family then bring it in to play with your friends at school.	Create some fruit rocket sticks using a range of different fruit.

Challenge activity Make a model of our solar system. Think about the different shapes and sizes.	Challenge activity Make up a song or rap about space.
