Question 1: What year group is your child in?



### Summary


94% of parents feel that the work their child is set is clear.

Weekly welcome videos and weekly learning timetables provide structure to support families with remote learning.

78% of pupils are completing all or most of the work.


14% of pupils are completing all of the work.

102 responses




#### Summary

## Question 5

How easy or difficult has it been to keep your child/children learning remotely at home?

102 responses



### Summary

The majority of families have found remote learning to have a mixture of easier and more challenging days as they juggle their jobs and support their children at home.

29% of families have found it easy to keep their children learning remotely at home, while 39% of families have found it more challenging.

Many families have found remote learning easier this time with Google Classroom, Seesaw, greater structure, easier communication and regular feedback from teachers.

Older children have shown greater independence with their remote learning, while younger children have required more attention and support.


Some families have found it more challenging to encourage focus and attention at home as it is not the children's usual learning environment.

Children have missed the interaction they would have in school with their friends.

## Question 6

How easy is it to communicate with, or get help from, your child's class teacher?

### Summary


88% of parents have found it easy to communicate with or get help from their child's class teacher.

Teachers have been very responsive with marking work and answering any questions children and parents may have on Google Classroom and Seesaw.

### Summary


90% of parents find our home learning platforms Google Classroom and Seesaw easy to use and navigate.

## Question 8

Is your child enjoying taking part in live calls?



102 responses



### Summary

71% of children are enjoying taking part in live calls.

Children are enjoying seeing their friends and teacher on live calls to help them with their learning.

The gradual roll out of calls has helped some families manage this new method of learning.


Children attending school have also really enjoyed accessing live calls with their class teacher and peers learning at home.

Some children have found this method of interaction more challenging, while other children have enjoyed live calls in smaller groups.

## Question 9

Does the new remote learning offer through Google Classroom better support you and your child with their home learning, compared to what was offered during the first lockdown (March 2020)?

99 responses



### Summary

92% of parents feel that the school's new remote learning offer better supports their child's learning at home compared to the first lockdown in March 2020, and have found communication with their child's teacher easy.

Many families have found teachers' weekly welcome videos and weekly learning timetables very helpful to structure each week, particularly now that it is in one central location on Google Classroom.


The learning materials that have been provided have been very helpful in supporting children's home learning and children are enjoying the opportunity to interact with their teacher and peers through live calls.

Many families with younger children have found the phonics videos very engaging and helpful to go back and watch to support their child with their learning at home.

## Question 10

Is there anything more the school can do to support you with your child's home learning? If yes, please comment below.

98 responses



### Summary

58% of parents feel well supported by the school with their child's remote learning.

42% of parents would like further support with their child's learning at home through:

More live lessons

Smaller group sizes for live lessons

Greater support for maths learning
