Imagine you are an evacuee. Write a postcard home to your parents, explaining what has happened to you. Consider how to effectively tell them about your new experiences, using descriptive vocabulary, contractions and modal verbs.		Bake or cook a wartime recipe – be careful when weighing and measuring the ingredients. Take photos to share if you can!		Design a parachute for a soldier that would keep them safe. Draw the parachute and label clearly. If you can, why not make an example of the parachute?	
Make a glossary of at least 10 words or phrases related to WW2 and explain what each of them mean. For example (billeting officer, search light, ARP warden.)		Research the size of the armies that fought in WW2. Can you put this information into a graph?		Create a presentation about the 10 items you would pack in your suitcase if you were being evacuated to another place today, giving your reasons for each item.	
Research Winston Churchill and write a factfile about him.		Find out what food items were rationed for a family each week during WWII. Calculate how much food your family would have had each month and year.		Research the fashion worn in the 1930s and 1940s. Compare and contrast the Wartime fashion with clothes worn today. Include drawings and accompanying annotations.	
Challenge activity Create a news report about a significant WW2 event e.g. The Blitz, The Battle of Britain. Film your news report and upload to Seesaw or type up on a computer.		Challenge activity Design a gas mask box; you will need to make a net for a cube or a cuboid and construct.		Challenge activity Research an aircraft, ship or tank that took part in WW2. Make a model, drawing or collage and include a description.
